

Installing KinderGate

System requirements

KinderGate works on the following operating systems:

- Windows XP/Vista/Windows 7, 8
- Linux (Ubuntu 12.04, 13.10, 14.04, AltLinux 7)
- Macintosh OSX 10.7.5 or later

Computer must have at least 2 GBytes of RAM and 200 Mbytes free space on the local hard drive.

Important: Computers on which KinderGate is installed must have HTTP and HTTPS access to the Internet.

Installing KinderGate on a Linux computer

To install KinderGate from the Entensys repository execute the following commands from the Linux console:

For Ubuntu 12.04

```
echo 'deb http://dc.entensys.com/ubuntu precise extra' | sudo tee -a /etc/apt/sources.list
wget http://dc.entensys.com/ubuntu/entensys.gpg -O - | sudo apt-key add -
sudo apt-get update
sudo apt-get install kindergate
```

For Ubuntu 13.10

```
echo 'deb http://dc.entensys.com/ubuntu saucy extra' | sudo tee -a /etc/apt/sources.list
wget http://dc.entensys.com/ubuntu/entensys.gpg -O - | sudo apt-key add -
sudo apt-get update
sudo apt-get install kindergate
```

For Ubuntu 14.04

```
echo 'deb http://dc.entensys.com/ubuntu trusty extra' | sudo tee -a /etc/apt/sources.list
wget http://dc.entensys.com/ubuntu/entensys.gpg -O - | sudo apt-key add -
sudo apt-get update
sudo apt-get install kindergate
```

For Alt Linux 7 x32

```
echo 'rpm http://dc.entensys.com/alt7 i686 extra' | sudo tee -a /etc/apt/sources.list
apt-get update
apt-get install kindergate
```

Important: For KinderGate to function, activate the trial or full version. You can activate
